

Board of Directors – Biographical Notes

Pedro Moreira is Chairman of the Board of Directors at EGEAC (Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural).

A History graduate from Lisbon University's School of Arts and Humanities, specialising in Palaeography and Diplomacy, he worked on the National Commission for the Commemoration of the Portuguese Discoveries/Presidency of the Council of Ministers. He was also Director of Cultural Development and Management at EGEAC, Director of Marketing and Visitor Attractions at Lismarketing/*Turismo de Lisboa* and Director of Operations at the Royal Treasure Museum at *Palácio Nacional da Ajuda - Turismo de Lisboa*.

Susana Graça is a member of the Board of Directors at EGEAC (Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural).

With a degree in Economics from the Lisbon School of Economics & Management at the University of Lisbon and a Master's and Doctorate in Philosophy from the Erasmus University Rotterdam, she was project manager of the European Media and Information Fund (EMIF) at the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation (2021-2022) and Advisor for EEA Grants and Economic Relations at the Norwegian Embassy in Lisbon (2017-2021). She is Adjunct Professor of the Economics of Culture at Lisbon Theatre and Film School and has held managerial roles at the Directorate-General for Arts, the Regional Directorate of Culture for Lisbon and the Tagus Valley, the Institute of Cinema and Audiovisual and the Portuguese Institute for the Performing Arts.

Manuel Falcão is a Non-Executive Member of the Board of Directors at EGEAC (Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural).

Having studied Medicine, Photography, Communication, Marketing and Media Strategy, he went on to found several publications: *Blitz*, *Independente* and *Visão*. He served as President of the Institute of Cinema and Audiovisual (1989-1990), was Director of the CCB Performing Arts Centre (1991-1992), administrator at the media and record label *Valentim de Carvalho*, President of the Association of Independent Television Producers and Director of Programmes at RTP2 television channel. He was a member of the EGEAC board of directors between 2002 and 2005 and General Director of the independent media group company *Nova Expressão, Planeamento de Media e Publicidade* from 2006 to 2020.

The new EGEAC governing bodies were elected at a public meeting of Municipal Council Leaders on 27 July, 2022 and took office on 8 August, 2022.
