



Board of Directors – Biographical Notes

Pedro Moreira is Chairman of the Board of Directors at EGEAC (Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural).

A History graduate from Lisbon University's Faculty of Letters, specialising in Palaeography and Diplomatic, he worked on the National Commission for the Commemoration of the Portuguese Discoveries/Presidency of the Council of Ministers. He was also Director of Cultural Development and Management at EGEAC, Director of Marketing and Visitor Attractions at Lismarketing/Turismo de Lisboa and Director of Operations at the Royal Treasury Museum at Palácio Nacional da Ajuda - Turismo de Lisboa.

Susana Graça is a member of the Board of Directors at EGEAC (Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural).

With a degree in Economics from the Higher Institute of Economics and Management at the University of Lisbon and a Master's and Doctorate in Philosophy from the Erasmus University Rotterdam, she was project manager of the European Media and Information Fund (EMIF) at the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation (2021-2022) and Advisor for EEA Grants and Economic Relations at the Norwegian Embassy in Lisbon (2017-2021). She is Adjunct Professor of the Economics of Culture at Lisbon Theatre and Film School and has held managerial roles at the Directorate-General for Arts, the Regional Directorate of Culture for Lisbon and the Tagus Valley, the Institute of Cinema and Audiovisuals and the Portuguese Institute for the Performing Arts.

Gonçalo Reis is a Non-Executive Member of the Board of Directors of Empresa de Gestão de Equipamentos e Animação Cultural (EGEAC).

He studied Economics at the Universidade Católica Portuguesa between 1987 and 1992 and completed an MBA at the University of Chicago in 1996. He has extensive management experience in both private and public companies and has held senior leadership positions in some of Portugal's largest companies: CEO of RTP, CFO of Estradas de Portugal, and Vice-President of Havas Portugal. He is currently serving as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Auto-Estradas Douro Litoral.

EGEAC's new governing bodies were elected at a public meeting of the city council on 27 July, 2022, and took office on 8 August, 2022. On 17 January, 2024, Gonçalo Reis was appointed to replace Manuel Falcão as a Non-Executive Member.
